



## **Back Gate**

The back gate in Locus Lake Village will allow 24 hour, 7 day week ingress and egress to the village by residents, with recorded video security.

Each member household in good standing will be issued two access cards to activate this automatic gate free of charge. The cards will be necessary to use the gate while entering or leaving the village. The cards do not have to be inserted into the card reader. The reader will recognize your card from 12"-16" away and the gate will open automatically. Remote control openers, similar to garage door openers, will be available for a charge.

For your visitors or delivery vehicles, a dial up keypad at the gate will ring a resident's telephone number after a four digit number is entered so residents can grant access from their home phone. When you answer your phone, you will be able to speak to the visitor and raise the gate by pressing "O" on your touchtone phone pad. A scrolling list of property owners will list the four digit codes of all members on the entry keypad. Members, if they prefer, can choose to not be listed on the directory by notifying the office in writing.

Emergency vehicles can utilize the gate through special technology. School buses will be issued gate cards to allow limited access only during the school day.

### **Locust Lake Village Electronic Gate Regulations**

Card entry and exit  
Rolodex entry only  
Do not lift gate arm  
Do not go around closed gate arm  
Piggy backing of vehicles prohibited  
Unauthorized card use prohibited

Violators of above or persons causing any damage subject to fine and restitution of any costs to equipment repair or replacement.
